

Outline and Rubric for a Live Demonstration

Steps:

1. Choose a task that you can perform (something you do at your placement) to a live class audience.
2. This task must take a minimum of 15-20 minutes to perform.
3. You must bring all materials and tools required.
4. Talk to your teacher about an appropriate location at school.
5. This must be something different than what you did for your Show and Share video.
